

Membership Covenant

Having been led, as we believe, by the Spirit of God,¹ to embrace Jesus as the Lord,² Savior,³ and supreme Treasure of our lives,⁴ and having been baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,⁵ we do now, in the presence of God,⁶ angels,⁷ and this assembly, most solemnly and joyfully enter into covenant with one another as one body in Christ.⁸

We engage, therefore, by the aid of the Spirit,⁹ to walk together in Christian love,¹⁰ to strive for the advancement of this church¹¹ in knowledge,¹² holiness,¹³ and peace;¹⁴ to promote its spirituality and fruitfulness;¹⁵ and to sustain its worship,¹⁶ ordinances,¹⁷ and discipline.¹⁸

We likewise engage, to uphold the Table Rock Member Affirmation of Faith; to welcome, test biblically, and apply instruction from the Scriptures by the Elders of the church which accords with the Table Rock Elder Affirmation of Faith; ¹⁹ to contribute cheerfully²⁰ and regularly²¹ to the support of the ministry,²² the expenses of this church,²³ the relief of the poor,²⁴ and the spread of the gospel in this city and among all the nations.²⁵ We also engage to maintain family²⁶ and personal devotions;²⁷ to seek the salvation of our friends, family, and neighbors;²⁸ to educate our children in the Christian faith;²⁹ to walk wisely in the world;³⁰ to be just in our dealings,³¹ faithful in our engagements,³² and exemplary in our conduct,³³ and to avoid all gossip,³⁴ slander,³⁵ excessive anger,³⁶ drunkenness,³⁷ and sexual sin.³⁸

We further engage to watch over one another in brotherly love;³⁹ to remember one another in prayer;⁴⁰ to aid one another in sickness and distress;⁴¹ to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling⁴² and courtesy in speech;⁴³ to be slow to take offense,⁴⁴ but always ready for reconciliation,⁴⁵ and mindful of the rules of our Savior to secure it without delay.⁴⁶

We moreover engage that when we remove from this place, we will notify the church leaders, and, if possible, unite with a like-minded church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant.⁴⁷
